Notice of Intended Entry onto Land – flood embankment remedial works at Kirton Creek, Suffolk on the River Deben

I write further to recent discussions with the Environment Agency's representative Emmett Klipalo in connection with the flood defence remedial works at Kirton Creek, Suffolk.

The works proposed are as follows;

1. The part-excavation of the crack along the central section using a surface trench which will be followed by staged re-compaction of the excavated material.
2. The stripping of existing topsoil material from the northern section's crest and landward/front faces and replacement with imported topsoil to be reseeded to allow new surface vegetation to establish.

This work is necessary to ensure that the embankments integrity is not compromised if overtopped.

This work is to last 4 working weeks with mobilisation to site scheduled on **Monday 08th of June 2020.**

Please find enclosed a Notice of Intended Entry on to Land on or after 08/06/2020.

NOTICE OF INTENDED ENTRY ONTO LAND

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In order to carry out these remedial works it is necessary for the Environment Agency and their contractor (Breheny Civil Engineering Ltd) to enter land which you own or occupy at Kirton Creek. Our powers to enter land for these purposes are set out in Section 172 of and Schedule 20 to the Water Resources Act 1991.

The Environment Agency hereby gives you notice that we propose to enter your land on or after 08/06/2020. Entry will continue until the purpose for which it is required is satisfied.

The proposed access route through Lodge Farm is highlighted as a pink dashed line on the enclosed plan. The red edged area indicates the site boundary and the black rectangle encloses the designated site compound area.


Our powers to carry out such works are set out in Section 165 of the Water Resources Act 1991 and Section 37 the Environment Act 1995.

An authorised officer entering onto land is entitled to take with him/her such other persons and equipment as may be necessary to carry out the Works.

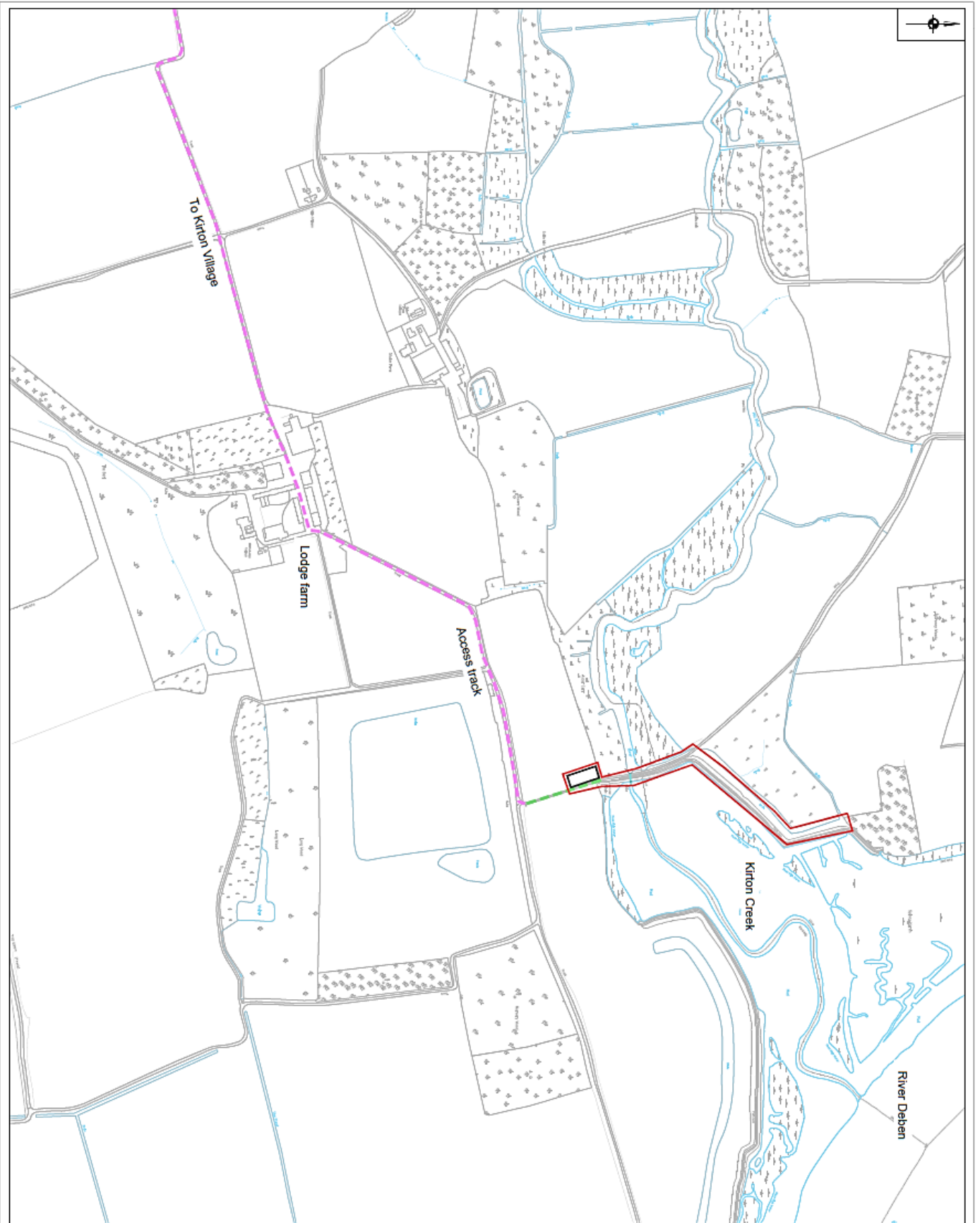

SCOPE OF WORKS:

- I. CRACK REPAIR AND REINFORCED GREST (APPROX. 12M) WITH ENVIRONMENTAL FELLETS.
- II. TOPSOIL REPLACEMENT IMPORTED TOPSOIL TO BE PLACED AT NORTHERN EXTENT OF EMBANKMENT. SPREAD ALONG THE ADJACENT FOLDING AND GRASS SEED TO BE SPREAD.
- III. OUTFALL STEP EXTENSION EXISTING OUTFALL GRS STEPS TO BE REINFORCED WITH DIMENSIONS OF GREST STRUNGERS AND HANDRAILS TO FOLLOW TO MATCH WITH REST OF THE STEPS. EXISTING TIMBER GATE TO BE RETAINED AND REUSED.
