2 MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on 4th September 2023 having been previously circulated were taken as read, approved and signed.

3 <u>DECLARATION OF INTERESTS</u>

Nothing declared.

4 **PUBLIC OPEN FORUM**

Police Report Nothing received.

<u>County Councillor's Report</u> A written report from Mrs P Mulcahy had been circulated, outlining the efforts made to protect against scams, anticipated overspends on school and care costs and object ion to cross county pylon proposals

<u>District Councillor's Report</u> The District Councillors' monthly report had been circulated and referred to concerns over lack of civic pride across the district, guidance on NSPI's, a new planning document and the ned to consider winter home heating. Mr Ninnmey spoke of the problems faced by the growing population and the lack of health facilities. Two enforcement officers are to be appointed. In answer to a question about the lack of dental services he explained that it is influenced by a shortage in general of surgeries and space.

PTLO Report Mr Hatrick had nothing to report.

<u>Tree Warden Report</u> Mr Brunt remains indisposed following an operation.

5 <u>MATTERS ARISING</u>

- i) <u>Alley hedge</u> Pauls had advised that the hard cut of hedge scheduled for December (230953).
- ii) <u>EAONE/THREE</u> Councillor Paul reported that ONE is nearly complete and details of THREE awaited.
- iii) Interchange verges On-going.
- iv <u>Joint Cross Parish Group</u> Councillor Fothergill reported that the Group had bee set up and held its first meeting (230951/75) that day; it had nothing to

progress currently. Thought may be given to inviting Felixstowe TC. Points noted included references to lorry parking for the Docks and suggestions it might revive "Innocence Lane", though inspectors report should be checked on this. Questions on the future development of the Local Plan in relation to the Strategic Planning for the Orwell and Villages Ward had been raised with ESC. Its response (230983) emphasised that it was concentrating on implementing the current Plan and there were no current plans for a review. Arising from the National Significant Infrastructure Projects (NSIP) Councillor Fothergill will be attending the SALC seminar "getting to grips with NSIPs" on the morning of 18th October.

Councillor Fothergil and the RFO had submitted background assessments (230915/934). Agreed the question of improving communication is a wide issue in particular as regards the future of the Review and should be considered in future agenda.

- i) <u>Community Pqartnership</u> Councillor Colvill had been unable to attend latest meeting; a subsequent report (230954) noted the group had agreed to focus on increasing activity for children and adults.

TRANSPORT

The government's £2.00 bus fare cap has been changed from 1 November. The cap was originally planned to run between January and March, 2023 but was later extended to 30 June and then again to 31 October, 2023 with a further cap of £2.50 planned until 30 November, 2024.
