2. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

I Cade in the chair; the minutes of the meeting held on12th June 2023 having been previously circulated were taken as read, approved and signed.

3. **DECLARATION OF INTERESTS**

Nothing new declared.

4. <u>PUBLIC OPEN FORUM</u>

<u>Police Report</u> None received. Noted it was some years since a police officer had attended a meeting. Clerk confirmed that an invitation to every meeting is sent.

Parishioners Questions Nothing raised.

<u>County Councillor's Report</u> Mrs Mulcahy had submitted a written report, highlighting support for users of pre-paid meters, a grant to Suffolk Archive for Arrivals Project

District Councillor Reports Messrs Ninnmey and Reeves had forwarded a report highlighting help for affordable school uniforms, distribution of daffodils, ESC environment commitment, "Shake Out" and its contribution to to UK Shared Prosperity Fund; suggested the school uniform item is put on web site. Each gave comments on the Levington Water issue, the Seven Hills Business Park, the A12 through Martlesham. Mr Ninnmey confirmed an interest in Self Build opportunities and Mr Reeves reported on Health and confirmed, in answer to a question, that his interests included Air Pollution considerations.

<u>PTLO Report</u> Mr Hatrick confirmed that the single fares of £2 would continue to October and then rise to £2.50 until November 2024.

Tree Warden Report

Mr Brunt, who was recovering from an operation, had expressed his frustration in dealing with planning applications involving a TPO and sensed a lack of co-operation on the part of ESC. The Council had considered recent applications for work on such trees in The Maltings and had sought a meeting with ES, which had failed to materialise. This had been posted by ESC as the Council's response to the planning applications, which was not the purpose of the communication.

The proposal to form a cross-parish group to liaise on matters of mutual interest had been supported all 7 parishes in the Orwell and Villages Ward had been supported by all parish with the exception of Trimley St Mary and Nacton PCs who had yet to respond. Councillors Fothergill and Colvill were delegated to co-ordinate an initial meeting with all representatives, possibly in September. Noted, could involve the whole of the Peninsular as the 5 year review of the Local Plan could be imminent.
