2. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on 12th December 2022 having been previously circulated were taken as read, approved and signed. By the Chairman.

3. **DECLARATION OF INTERESTS**

4. PUBLIC OPEN FORUM

<u>County Councillor's Report</u> Written report received, seeking confirmation of finger post order and response from Highways Flood team that report and photos passed to Highways assessment Officer; logged as report CR379738.

PTLO Report Mr Hatrick had nothing new to report

<u>Tree Warden Report</u> Mr Brunt had been pursuing Burnt House Lane/Falkenham Road oak tree and determined that tree is in the Highway verge and so is the responsibly of SCC. Clerk will ask Patti Mulcahy for assistance in raising with County Highways.

5. MATTERS ARISING

- i) <u>Rectory Lane finger post</u> Agreed that sketches provided by SCC fulfil requirements (221920/2/3,221320). And Clerk to ask Mrs Mulcahy to progress order confirming that fingers will point in the correct directions. Noted that no picture of the actual post has been seen.
- ii) Tree lighting The event (2211350) had been a great success attended by 100+parishioners and children. During the singing of carols, accompanied by Mrs Jean Walker on accordion, a collection of £225 was taken which will be donated to St John's Parish Pantry. The children's choir form Trimley St Martin School were particularly commended for leading Away in a Manger. Agreed the new lights look good. BHBI had confirmed (221314) that the new

lights are covered under Street Lighting.

- iii) Speeding signage Nothing to report.
- iv) EAONE/THREE Some hedge replacement in hand.
- v) <u>Ease the Squeeze</u> Following the withdrawal of the White Horse from the scheme (221299), attempts were in hand to find alternative locations. ESC had agreed (221354) for the Support grant of £2340 be retained for the time being. May be possible to revise the initiative should rising heating bills give rise to needs for "warm rooms".
- vi) Trimley Interchange Nothing to report.

6. **ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS**

- i) <u>Felixstowe Community Partnership</u> Councillor Colvill would have attended the meeting on 30th November (221278); report awaited. Councillor Colvill had responded to the TC/PC Support survey (221337) on the Council's behalf.
- ii) <u>Register of Electors</u> Clerk had requested a copy of the 2022/3 Register (221334).
- iii) Grow your Own Noted assistance available from ESC (221328).

7. **FINANCE**

- i) <u>Finance/monitoring reports</u> RFO presented reports to 8th December, verified by Councillor Jacobs. He explained that grant receipts are distorting the budget; the cost of the tree lights had been taken from reserves. The Clerk's salary had been slightly adjusted to align with the Living Wage to accord with the previous agreement between the Clerk and the Council.
- ii) <u>Precept</u> The RFO had submitted a Precept request of £24845 (221275) for the period 2023/4
- iii) Grants An appeal from CAB Suffolk had been received (221333) subsequent to the decisions on grants at the meeting on 14th November. The Clerk explained that the grant to Suffolk Disability Forum could not be realised as it is totally financed by ESC. Following a suggestion that grant should be offered to the Disability Advice Service, proposed D Jacobs, seconded P Lickert and carried, that the grant be made to DAS and not CAB, as the most appropriate disability charity. Grant acknowledgements had been received from SARS, Headway, MAGPAS, EACH, Homestart.
