**Minutes of Parish Council Meeting held on
Monday 2nd February 2015 at 7.30 pm in the Recreation Ground Pavilion**

PUBLIC OPEN FORUM

PRESENT 9 Parish Councillors, Mrs S B Harvey (DC), 10 Parishioners.

The Chairman opened the meeting by explaining that in view of the open discussion on planning matters to follow, the usual POF reports (below) will be taken as read.

1. **Police Report**

Written report circulated (c150126), recorded a burglary in Struston Mead

2. **Parishioners Questions** Nothing raised.

3. **County Councillor's Report**

Written report circulated from Mrs O'Brien (c150101), recorded sentencing of manager of company following complaints to Trading Standards, Suffolk Carers success in "Going the Extra Mile", and a Police and Crime Panel report.

4. **District Councillors' Reports**

Written reports circulated from Mrs Harvey and Mr R Kerry (c150129/22). The former reported on Hastoe Housing criteria on change of ownership and shared equity, attendance at FPAAP working group, and expenditure of enabling grant to KAFPA for staging and other possibilities, the latter on grants from Coastal Communities Fund towards Tourism, planning issues around affordable housing and Felixstowe Port development matters.

5. Councillor Cade introduced an open discussion on two outstanding planning issues.

1. **DC14/4225 Land rear of 16 to 22 Falkenham Road, Kirton
Demolish existing building; and redevelop site to provide
39 dwellings, etc "B & M Site"**

2. Felixstowe Peninsular Area Action Plan

Councillor Cade displayed a draft Parish Council response (c150128) to the proposals for the B & M site, questions being raised from the floor on drainage, footpath provision and Rights of Way.

A similar Parish Council draft response was displayed on the FPAAP proposals (c150127). In the light of the public meeting held in Kirton Church Hall on 27th January the discussion was limited to broad outlines of public feeling, and clarification on the implications from removing the Falkenham boundary envelope and significance of those parts of Falkenham included in the Kirton planning envelope. .

Proposed J Shaw, seconded EY Choi and carried that these drafts should form the basis of

the Parish Council's responses, and Councillor Cade would circulate updated drafts for comment and final agreement, to meet the scheduled response dates.

The chairman expressed the thanks of the Council for all his work in steering through these two planning issues in the Public Meeting and with SCDC.

The Chairman closed the Open Meeting at 9 pm and opened Parish Council meeting.

Pavilion : All Ok – just a minor problem with a window handle in the lounge.

Play-Area : Still waiting for work to be done on the slide, adult swings, roundabout and gate !!

New Equipment : All Ok.

Ground : Work has started on the new entrance. There will just be one gate instead of the two thus making access much less cumbersome. Parking will be available to the left of the new entrance. Still problems with dog mess – there must be a record number of dogs now using the ground.
