Minutes of Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 15th March 2021 at 7.30 pm by Remote Zoom

PARISH COUNCIL

PRESENT: Messrs I Cade, J Fothergill, A P Hutton, D Jacobs, P J Lickert, R J Osborne, M A Paul (chairman), Ms EY Choi, Mesdames E A Colvill, J Durrant, J L Shaw, G J Walker (RFO) and 2 Parishioners.

2. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on Monday 15th February 2021 having been previously circulated were taken as read, approved and signed.

3. **DECLARATION OF INTERESTS**

Nothing new offered

ACTION

4. **MATTERS ARISING**

- i) Quiet Lanes Councillor Shaw gave an update on the process so far (210266/269) for Quiet Lane to be established on Back/Brook/Church Lanes. A response from the Parish Council was required by the end of April. Agreed by a vote of 6 to 5 that the Consultation Notice (210240) be circulated to parishioners and be an open discussion item on the Annual Meeting Agenda of 12th April 2021 to determine degree of approval.
- ii) <u>Rectory Lane signpost</u> Councillor Choi had finally obtained from SCC a breakdown of costs (c210191) but there were still outstanding issues. On the nature of the Heritage sign. Agreed Councillors Choi, Hutton and Jacobs should pursue the option of having the sign repaired.
- iii) <u>Flooding</u> There as no progress to report. Flooding opposite 32 Falkenham Road had now subsided but no action from SCC can be expected in the near future.
- iv) <u>Community workshop</u> The Clerk had attended the remote meeting on 18th February (210184) at which the primary topic had been CIL; the notes (219244) had been circulated, together with the latest Small Grants Scheme (210277). The next meeting is on 22nd April (210256).
- v) Trimley interchange Councillor Cade had had discussions with the Clerk of Trimley St Martin PC. It had been pursuing the condition of hedges with SCC but had not achieved any action. A working party is looking into cycle path diversions.-
- vi) Cycles on footpaths Councillor Fothergill had had discussed the problems

with Kevin Proctor (210288), who had walked some the footpaths/bridleways. He saw no obvious damage caused by cycles, although tractor use had made some nearly impassable; some motorcycle tyre tracks on the bridleways and footpaths had been spotted. He offered some suggestions on the need for improvement to signs to avoid confusion. Councillor Paul reported that SCC had been erecting new signs.

- vii) RG/VG Land Registration Response from Land Registry still awaited
- viii)) EAONETHREE The new Falkenham entrance should be started later in he month.

5. **PUBLIC OPEN FORUM**

Police ASB remote meeting on 26th February (210194) was not attended. Circular on Hare coursing (210313) circulated and noted.

County Council Written report from Mrs O' Brien (210306) noted the setting of the budget for 2021/22 increasing expenditure by £41m to include Covid 19 costs, the introduction of ANPR at recycling centres and support for the creation of a Freeport at Felixstowe.

Fish and Chip van Proposed D Jacobs, seconded A Colvill and agreed by 9 votes to 1. that a fish and chip van application for Friday afternoons on the VG presented through Councillor Osborne (210317) be permitted; access to the VG to be by phone box.

6. **ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS**

- i) Parking Kirton Road Traffic Order from SCC (210235) confirming waiting restrictions around school noted.
- ii) Cyber security Advice from NALC (210292) noted and agreed C'K/COUNC consideration needs to be given to long term security of Council data.

7. **ANNUAL PARISH/PARISH COUNCIL MEETINGS**

Due to Covid restrictions Annual Parish Meeting will be held remotely on **CLERK** 12th April; agenda to be restricted to minutes, discussion on Quiet Lanes and emergency plan. In view of apparent Government reluctance to confirm continuity of remote meetings and general agreement of the Councillors that face-to-face are not yet acceptable, agreed the APCM should be brought forward to 10th May.

8. PLAYGROUP CLOSURE

Communication from chairman of Village Hall (210290) advised that alternative arrangements to reopen playgroup are in hand, but extensive refurbishment of facilities in the hall will have to be undertaken. Estimates are being sought and grant assistance was sought from the Council. Agreed SCC/CC should be asked to reallocate the Community Grant money for Rectory Road sign be reallocated to this purpose.
